The Glory of Christmas

"And the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us, and we saw His glory."

On Christmas, as we hear in my favorite Christmas song, *O Holy Night*, "the weary world rejoices." God gave us a Savior. We did not deserve this gift. We sinned. We betrayed God. We knew His laws, but we did what we wanted anyway and pushed Him away. But, in His immense love, He looked at this world of human beings He created in His image and likeness and His heart was filled with love. And in this immense love, He sent His Son.

The night that Christ was born truly changed the world. All of God's promises in the Old Testament were fulfilled, and in His death we can live. Eternity with God can be ours. We all have something that has created a barrier between us and Our Lord. Our gift to Baby Jesus could be to begin to tear that barrier down.

Remember, our lives are not our own. They belong to Christ. This Christmas, let us not forget that we are His. Let us find joy in this fact and give Him the greatest gift we possibly can—ourselves.

And this Christmas, and always, let us praise and thank Him for taking on our sins and for dying so that we could have eternal life.

Indeed, the weary world rejoices when it gazes upon Baby Jesus, on Christmas day and every day. Merry Christmas!

- Golfer registration/check-in begins at 10:45 AM. Free range balls from 11:15 AM to 12:15 PM. The putting and sand blast competition is from 11:00 AM to 12:15PM. Shotgun start at 12:30 PM.
- A hotdog/chips/soda lunch special is available in the Pro Shop for just \$4.00.
- This will be a 4-person step-aside scramble. Choose the flight your team will compete in: 'Players' (any age), 'Masters' (all players age 70+), 'Gamers' (2 or more women on team).
- Price includes range balls, dinner following the tournament, and awards for winning teams.
- Early-bird price is \$360 per team. Registration must include team payment for four golfers and \$25 for each extra dinner guest. Early-bird entries must be received by 3/11/24.
- \$380 per team after 3/11/24. Team registration and extra dinner(s) payment is due 3/25/24.
- Your foursome will want to buy the optional Team Super-Ticket for an extra \$60. This gives your players entry into the putting/sand blast contest before the tournament, eligibility for all on-course challenges (long drives, closest-to-the-pin), and 8 feet of "gimme" tape to lower your team score and speed-up play.
- Tournament is capped at 32 teams and sold out last year. Tournament is open to adults only.
- A limited number of power carts are available for rent. Carts are reserved for non-residents of Sun City West/Sun City Grand. Locals will ride with friends owning power carts (gas or electric) or borrow one!
- The catered Italian dinner and charity raffle immediately follow the tournament at Prince of Peace Parish's Hall, 14818 W. Deer Valley Dr., Sun City West. Adult beverages will be available.
