<u>Finance Council Notes on the</u> November State of the Parish Report

November Revenue

- For November 2023, total revenue was below budget by \$11,000.
- Plate income was below budget by \$19,000, due in part to the November budget projection including a one-time gift in November 2022 that was included in plate income trending.
- Weekly giving a averaged \$21,600 as compared to a budget of \$26,230 and last year's average of \$22,060. Faith Direct was 42% of total plate income.

November Expenses

- November operating expenses were \$3,000 under budget.
- Compensation expenses and Program expenses were under budget by \$5,000 combined while Supplies expense and Professional Fees expense were over budget by \$2,000.

Year-to-Date Revenue

- Year-to-Date revenue was \$16,000 over budget, with Plate income leading the way being \$11,000 over budget and Gold Envelopes being \$3,000 over budget. Total Plate income covers 101% of cash expenses.
- Year-to-Date Average Weekly Giving is \$19,505 compared to the budget of \$19,003 and prior year of \$19,730.

Year-to-Date Expenses

- Year-to-Date Operating expenses are \$14,000 under budget. Compensation and Program Expense are \$27,000 under budget while Utilities, Professional Services and Other expenses are \$13,000 over budget.
- Capital expense remain the same for the year currently.


