Stations of the Cross in St. John Paul II Chapel

These Stations of the Cross -- delicately hand-carved in Israel from mother-of -pearl -- were donated on January 19, 2023 by Prince of Peace Parishioners **George and Gwen Dushan**, on behalf of George's maternal aunt, **Peg Stefan** of Florence, AZ. The donation completed a six-decade mission of devotion to find a permanent home for the beautiful carvings.

During the 1950's and 60's, Peg Stefan was Sister Mary Faith, an educator and a Religious Sister of the Dominican Order in Wisconsin. During the early Sixties, she and fellow Sisters came across these Stations of the Cross at an abandoned chapel site, boxed and awaiting disposal. But, upon inquiring, the Sisters were permitted to save them. As time passed, Sister Mary Faith, later Mrs. Peg Stefan, preserved these treasures, all the while seeking a church or parish that needed them.

Fast-forward to January 12, 2023. During what became the Dushan's final visit with her, their Aunt Peg explained the story of the intricate carvings and sought their help in donating them. Suffering from a lengthy battle with latestage brain cancer, she was preparing for final hospice care.

One week later, **Father David Ostler** gratefully accepted the donation on behalf of Prince of Peace Parish. These Stations of the Cross had finally found a home.

Sadly, at that same hour, Peg Stefan had entered hospice.

She died the following morning, her lengthy mission now complete.
