

<u>Finance Council Notes on the August</u> <u>State of the Parish Report</u>

- Plate income continues to be above budget in August. The weekly average plate income was 16.4% more than budget and 24% more than last year for the same period. Total income was 21.8% more than the budget and 30.4% more than last year for the same period.
- Operating expenses were 3.4% more than the budget and 8.6% more than last year. Electric expenses were over budget. As were Diocesan insurance costs. Outside janitorial services were more than budget due to a late invoice and preparation of the new Parish Rectory. The Bishop's Assessment was over budget due to higher ordinary income.
- Year to date total income is 20.3% more than budget and 18.4% more than last year.
- Year to date operating expense is 2.3% less than the budget and 5.9% more than last year.
- Capital projects in the first quarter of the of the year included the roof on the total facility, the Parish Rectory, the new hearing assist system in the Church and the backflow valve in the sprinkler system in the Church.


