

40 Days of Prayer & Fasting for the Defeat of Proposition 139 Defending the Unborn Child and the <u>Mother</u>

What is Proposition 139?

Proposition 139 is a proposition on the November ballot that will enshrine the constitutional right to virtually unrestricted abortion through all nine months of pregnancy in Arizona.

All parishioners are encouraged to join Fr. David in prayer, fasting, and action for the defeat of Proposition 139 until Election Day.

- Fasting and abstaining from meat on Wednesdays and Fridays through Monday, November 4th
- Pray the Rosary or Memorare daily
- Pray in front of Planned Parenthood, 5771 W. Eugie Ave., Glendale
- Election Day Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5th

<u>Action</u>

- Talk to family and friends about this proposition using the palm cards
- Take extra palm cards and handout to others
- Place yard signs in front of your house

This proposition can be defeated in Arizona, but each of us will need to stand up and do our part to defend life.
