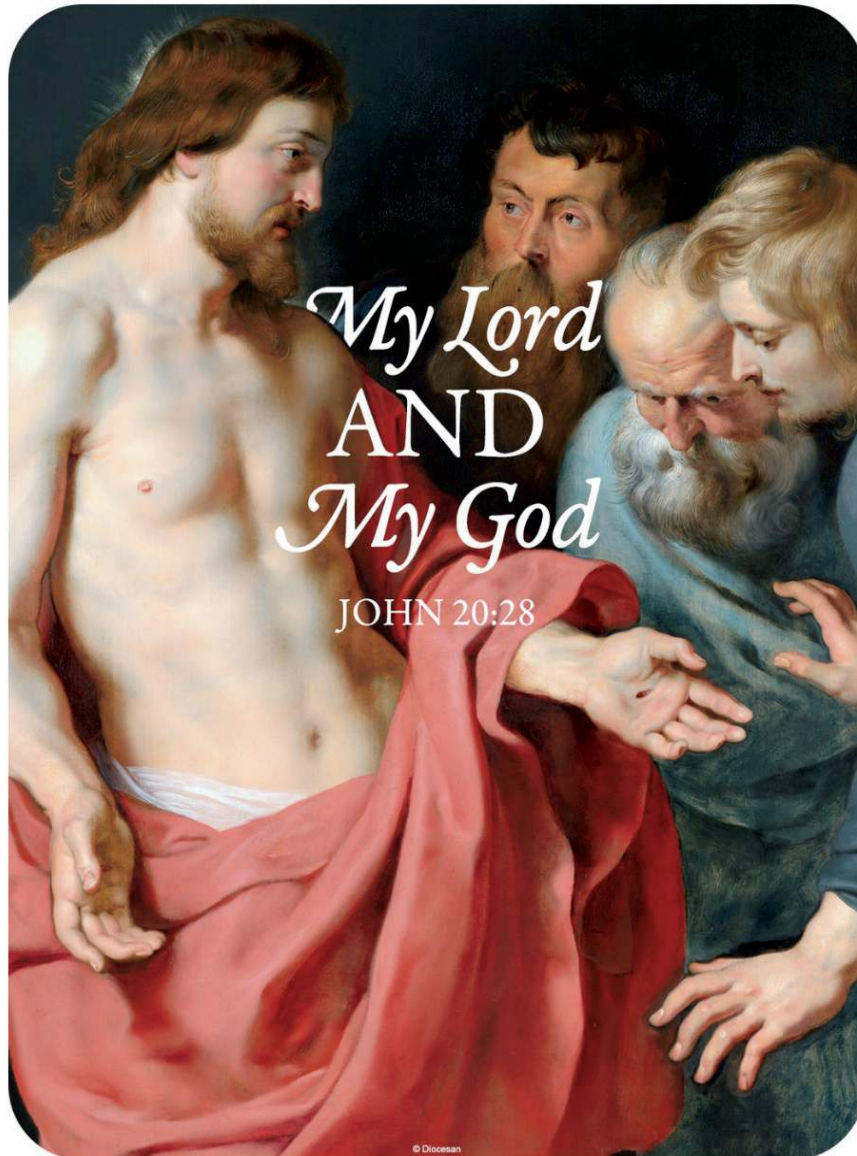

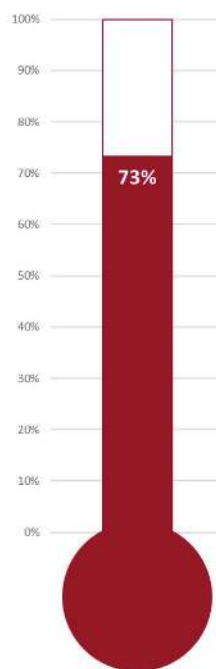

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

On the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast established by Pope John Paul II and rooted in the revelations given to Saint Faustina Kowalska.

What is Divine Mercy?

Divine Mercy is God's infinite love made visible in Jesus Christ, especially through His Passion, Death, and Resurrection. From His pierced Heart flow the graces of forgiveness and new life. The Church teaches that we are called to place complete trust in His mercy, which leads us to salvation: "Jesus, I trust in You."

On this day, the faithful are invited to:

- Turn to God with sincere repentance
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation
 - Worthily receive Holy Communion
- Practice works of mercy toward others

Special Grace of Divine Mercy Sunday

The Church also offers a plenary indulgence on this day. By going to Confession (within about 20 days), receiving Holy Communion, praying for the intentions of the Holy Father, and being free from all attachment to sin, the faithful may receive the full remission of temporal punishment due to sin.
