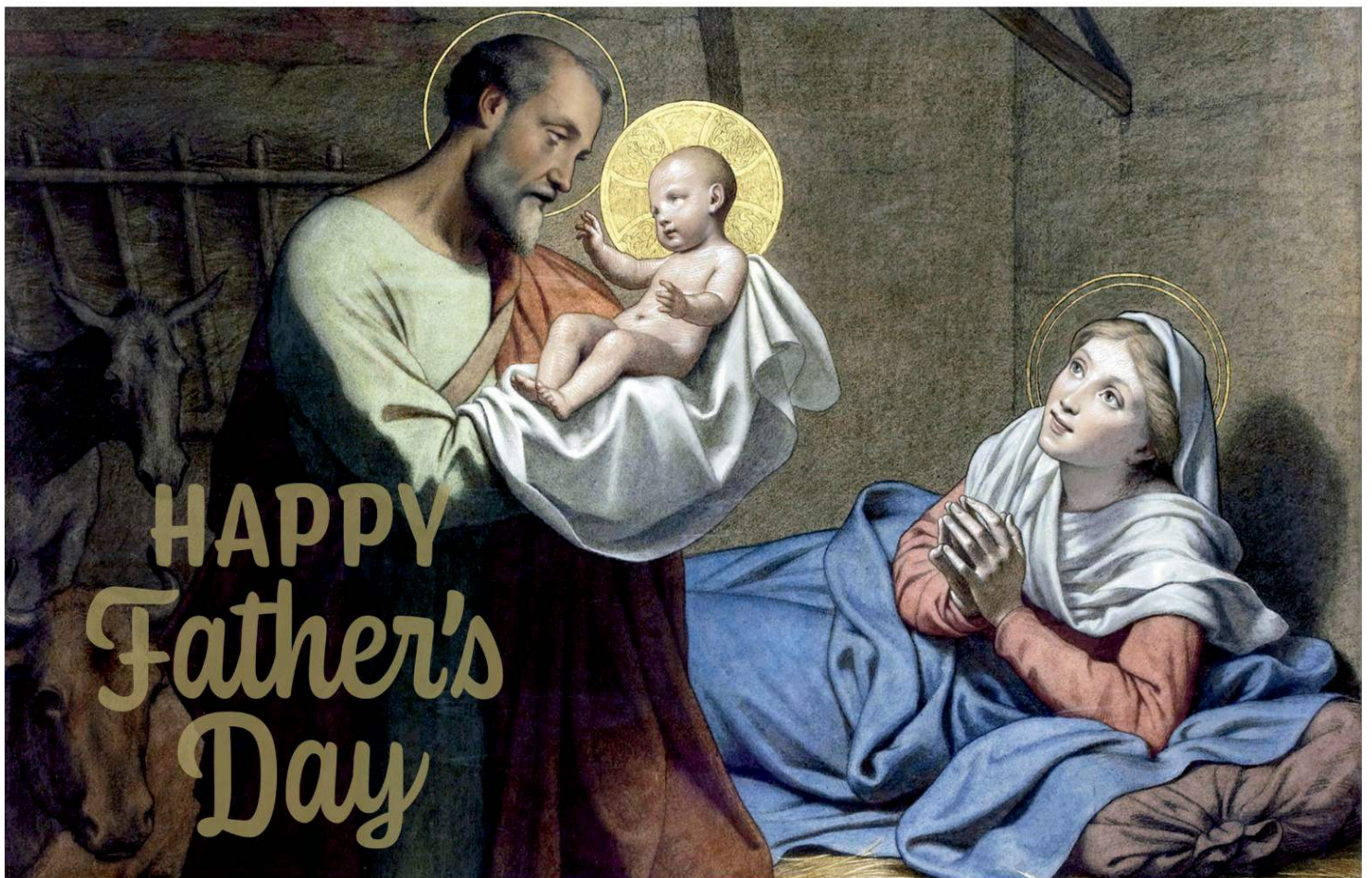

FEAR NO ONE

A REFLECTION ON MATTHEW 10:26-33

“So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.”

MATTHEW 10:31



In this Sunday’s Gospel, Jesus is preparing the Twelve Apostles for their mission. He has chosen them, instructed them, and is now sending them out to proclaim the Kingdom of God. But Jesus knows that not everyone will welcome their message. Some will reject them, criticize them, and even persecute them. That is why He begins with the command: *“Fear no one.”*

Jesus is teaching an important lesson about Christian discipleship. The Apostles are not responsible for how others receive the Gospel; they are responsible for faithfully proclaiming it. “What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.” The truths Christ entrusted to His followers were never meant to remain hidden. The Gospel is meant to be shared openly and courageously.

Jesus then draws a distinction between what is temporary and what is eternal. He says, “Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul.” In other words, earthly difficulties, while real, are not the greatest concern of a disciple. Our relationship with God and the salvation of our souls are of far greater importance than human approval, popularity, or comfort.

To reassure His disciples, Jesus points to the sparrows. In the ancient world, sparrows were among the least expensive birds sold in the marketplace—small, common, and easily overlooked. Yet even these tiny creatures are known and cared for by God. If not one sparrow falls to the ground without the Father’s knowledge, how much more does He care for His children?

Jesus emphasizes this with a striking image: “Even all the hairs of your head are counted.” This is not simply a poetic expression. It is a vivid way of teaching that God’s knowledge of us is complete and His care for us is personal and constant. We are never forgotten, overlooked, or alone. We belong to Him.

Finally, Jesus speaks about acknowledging Him before others. “Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father.” Faith is not meant to remain hidden or confined to Sunday worship. It should shape our daily lives, our decisions, our conversations, and our relationships. Every Christian is called to bear witness to Christ through both word and example.

This witness does not require extraordinary courage in every moment, but rather the willingness to be honest about who we are and what we believe. It might mean speaking about our faith when the opportunity arises, inviting someone to Mass, living with integrity in our work, forgiving when it is difficult, or standing up for what is right with charity and respect. In all these ways, we acknowledge Jesus before others.

As members of our parish family, we are invited to hear this Gospel as a call to greater trust and courage. When we remember that God knows us, loves us, and watches over us, we can live our faith with confidence, unafraid to proclaim the Good News in the world around us.
