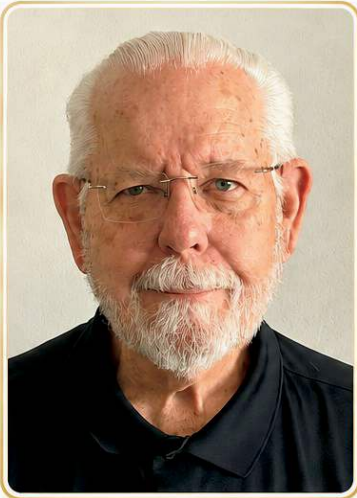

Dear Prince of Peace Parishioners,

I would like to introduce myself. I am Deacon Tom Willis. I was born and raised in southeastern Ohio. I grew up on a farm and attended Catholic School from first to eighth grade. After high school, I attended Ohio University for a short time before enlisting in the Army in 1967. I was a combat medic in Vietnam. In 1970, after completing my military service, I attended Cochise College, where I studied Criminal Justice and played baseball. I also married my wife, Delia, that year.

After graduating in 1972, I began my career with the Arizona Department of Public Safety. I served as a highway patrolman in Benson for five years and was then assigned to the Criminal Investigations Bureau in Douglas. In 1983, I transferred to the Special Investigations Unit in Phoenix. We lived in Phoenix until my retirement in 1992. At that time, Delia transferred into a new position in Cochise County, so we moved back to Douglas. In 1997, I was hired as a Commander for the Cochise County Sheriff's Office and served there for almost six years.

In 2004, I began my diaconate formation and was ordained in 2008. I served at St. Luke's Parish in Douglas until we moved to Tucson in 2012. I was assigned to St. Ambrose Parish and to the Diocese of Tucson Tribunal Office, both of which I have served for the last 14 years.

We moved to Peoria in 2024 to be closer to our family. We have three children and four grandchildren. Two of our children and their spouses live in Peoria. I enjoy spending time with family, hunting, and baking. I also occasionally enjoy a round of golf with our sons and son-in-law.

I am deeply grateful to Bishop Dolan for assigning me to the Prince of Peace Parish, and I would also like to thank Fr. Rey for graciously accepting my assignment.
