Why Is the Assumption of Mary Not a Holy Day of Obligation This Year?



Each year on August 15, the Church
celebrates the Solemnity of the
Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary,
commemorating Mary's being taken
body and soul into heavenly glory.
It is one of the Holy Days of Obligation
in the United States.



However, this year the Assumption
falls on a Saturday. According to the
norms established by the Catholic
bishops of the United States, when
January 1 (Mary, Mother of God),
August 15 (the Assumption), or
November 1 (All Saints) falls on a
Saturday or a Monday, **the obligation
to attend Mass is removed.**

The feast itself remains an important
solemnity and will still be celebrated
at Mass, but Catholics are not
required to attend Mass that day.



Even without the obligation, the
Assumption is a beautiful opportunity
to honor Our Blessed Mother and
reflect on the promise of the
resurrection that awaits all who
follow Christ faithfully.



Parishioners are encouraged to attend
8 AM MASS
on **SATURDAY, AUGUST 15**
if they are able and to ask Mary's intercession
for our parish and families.
