Join us for an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in a beautiful communal service. Please arrive a little early to sign in and obtain a name tag.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is available to those of the faithful who are seriously ill due to physical or mental illness. The Sacred Anointing may be conferred on people of advanced age whose strength has been much weakened, even if a serious illness is not apparent. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after having received the Anointing, or if, as the same sickness continues, there is a more serious relapse.

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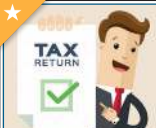
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
