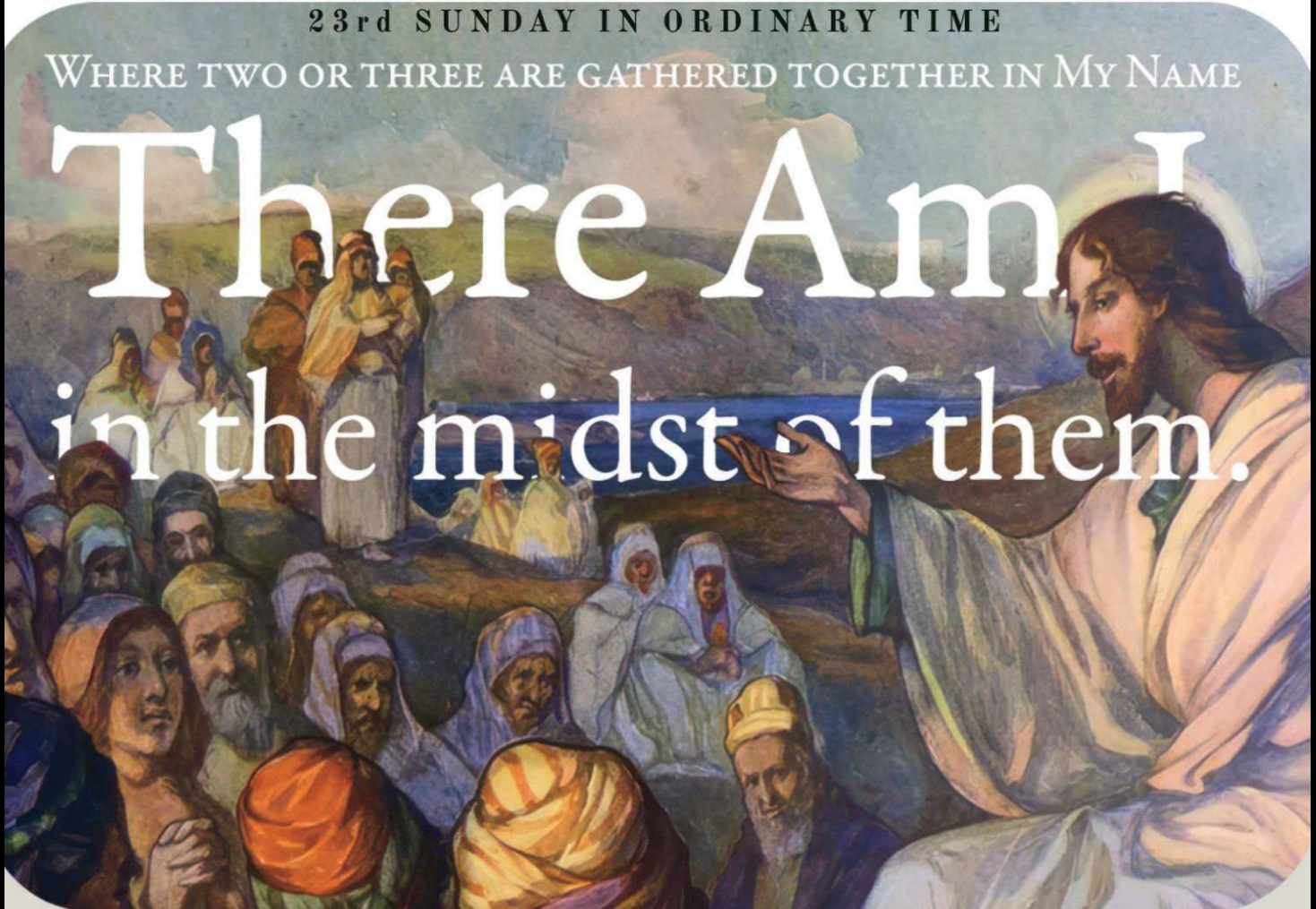

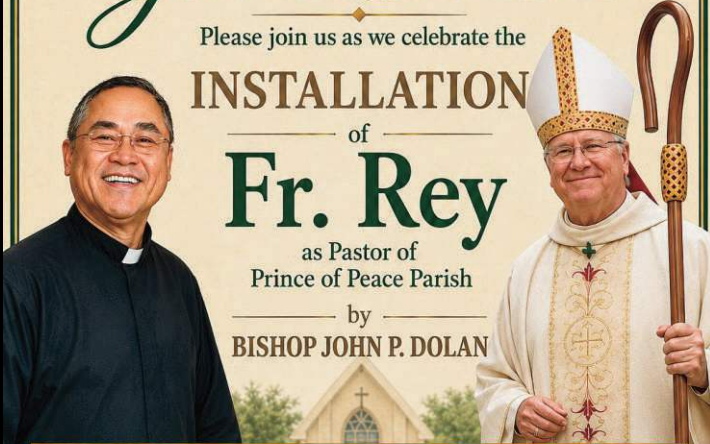

New Vestment Care Ministry

Do you enjoy serving behind the scenes? Do you have a gift for sewing, organizing, laundry care, or attention to detail? Prince of Peace is launching a new **Vestment Care Ministry**, and we are looking for volunteers to help care for the sacred vestments used in our liturgies.

Just as Martha lovingly prepared a place for the Lord, members of this ministry help prepare and care for the garments used in the worship of God. This ministry plays an important role in supporting the beauty and dignity of the Mass. Volunteers will help inspect priest and deacon vestments, coordinate dry cleaning when needed, launder albs and altar server cassocks and surplices, and ensure that the vestments used in worship are clean, presentable, and well cared for.

We are also seeking parishioners with sewing skills who would be willing to mend vestments, replace buttons or hooks, make simple repairs, and assist with occasional sewing projects.

Volunteer opportunities include:

Vestment Care Team: Inspect vestments, coordinate cleaning, and assist with laundering albs and server garments.

Vestment Sewing Team: Mend vestments and liturgical garments and help preserve these important items for years to come.
