**Sunday Family Catechesis Tuition**

The tuition covers a portion of the program expenditures. The parish subsidizes the remaining costs. No family will be denied Sunday Catechesis or being able to participate in any parish function due to financial difficulties. In these matters, families should contact the Director of Catechesis at (623) 344-7294. In addition to Liturgical Catechesis, we will incorporate concepts of Theology of the Body for families this upcoming year.

The **2024/2025 Sunday Catechesis tuition is set at \$140.00 per registered/contributing family**. Families may not be combined with other extended family members. Tuition for non-registered parishioner tuition is \$250.00 per year.

**Tuition will be due at the time of registration.**

**Sacramental Preparation Registration is conducted separately.** Families who wish for their child(ren) to be enrolled into Sacramental Preparation must also be enrolled in the Sunday Catechetical program or an approved Homeschooling program and be able to demonstrate their learning.

**Note: Due to the growth of our program, we will have limited class sizes this year, which might cause you not to be assigned the session time of your preference, but we will try to accommodate as best as we can. We will have twenty-five family slots per session. Families with children in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program for the 2023/2024 catechetical formation year will have priority for the 10:45 – 11:45 registration.**

**\*\*If your child(ren) will be preparing for any of the Sacraments, they will need to register for both the Sunday Catechetical program AND the respective Sacramental preparation program. Sunday Catechesis is a foundation program and runs alongside Sacramental Preparation. Therefore, they are two different programs uniquely tied to one another.\*\***

**Classes will begin on Sunday, September 8, 2024, and run through to Sunday, May 25, 2024.** Exact Calendar will be available on June 1, 2024.

**Volunteer Opportunities – Where can you help?**

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**Family Catechesis: At least one parent is expected to remain with their children during the assigned session. They can either volunteer in the classroom or participate in the small groups discussion with other parents.**

**Catechist:** Be prepared to teach the weekly Catechesis sessions (Lesson plans are provided to the catechists.) and agree to attend regular catechetical meetings and formation classes throughout the year.

**Assistant Catechist:** Assist the Catechist within the class, and possibly substitute for the Catechist when needed. Also agrees to attend regular catechetical meetings and formation classes throughout the year.

**Office Support:** Distribution of paperwork, making copies, filing, attendance and other duties in relationship to catechesis, youth and family ministry. (This can also be done during the week.)

**Substitute:** Is placed as an on-call basis to act as Catechist or Assistant in the classrooms when we are short staffed.

**Small Group Parent Formation Session each week:** Using the Christ in the Neighborhood series published by the diocese, parents will have an opportunity to talk about the weekly readings and engage in ideas to keep the message of the readings alive in their domestic church.
